I am sharing the following updates on behalf of the **CFMM Personnel Team** consisting of Suzanne Hull, Bruce Jenkins, Earl Yamashita (deacon representative) and myself. The following is what we have accomplished during Spring 2019 and upcoming projects for the last half of 2019.

### COMPLETED

- Created all new Associate Pastor job description (passed church vote on December 4, 2018.)
- Revised ALL CFMM staff job descriptions (balance of positions to be passed for church vote during August Business Meeting).
- Created a new Interim Pastor and an Interim Part-Time Praise/Youth Leader job description (passed church vote on May 28, 2019.)
- Posted Interim Part-Time Praise/Youth Leader job announcements on several websites.

### IN PROGRESS/FUTURE

- **Interim Part-Time Praise/Youth Leader** posting/search – Until the position is filled; Donne Soga and I continue to lead a structured **Youth Small Group (for youth grades 6-12)**. We facilitate **Right Now Media** studies which are written by and feature well-known Pastors who have a heart for helping our youth develop a deeper relationship with Jesus.
